Meeting Report

Agenda item 1. Opening remarks

Mr. KONDO Kazumasa, Deputy Chief of Mission, Embassy of Japan in Mongolia, the Co-Chair of the Japanese side, opened the eighth meeting of the Joint Committee (JC) of the Joint Crediting Mechanism (JCM) and gave opening remarks.

Mr. Bat-Ulzii B, Director General, Ministry of Environment and Climate Change, the Co-Chair of the Mongolian side gave opening remarks.

Agenda item 2. Organizational matters

Agenda item 2.1 Adoption of the agenda

The JC considered the draft agenda and adopted it.

Agenda item 2.2 Approval of attendance of observers

The JC consented to the participation of the attendees who were other than governmental officials at this JC meeting that they have no current professional, financial or other interest which could: i) significantly impair the individual's objectivity in carrying out his or her duties for the Joint Committee, or ii) create an unfair advantage for any person or organization by the attendees.

Agenda item 3. Issuance of JCM credits

The JC considered request for issuance of JCM credits of the following projects and decided to notify each government to issue the amount of JCM credits requested.

- Installation of 12.7 MW Solar Power Plant for Power Supply in Ulaanbaatar Suburb (MN003)
 - For Mongolian side: 34,069 tCO_{2eq}
 - For Japanese side: 25,701 tCO_{2eq}
 - Vintage: From 1 January 2021 to 31 December 2024

- 10MW Solar Power Project in Darkhan City (MN004)
 - For Mongolian side: 26,428 tCO_{2eq}

For Japanese side: 26,430 tCO_{2eq}

Vintage: From 1 January 2021 to 31 December 2024

- Introduction of 15MW Solar Power System near New Airport (MN006)

For Mongolian side: 63,604 tCO_{2eq}

For Japanese side: 27,261 tCO_{2eq}

Vintage: From 1 January 2021 to 31 December 2024

- Installation of 5MW Solar PV System and 3.6MWh Battery Energy Storage System in Zavkhan Province (MN007)

For Mongolian side: 3,375 tCO_{2eq}

For Japanese side: 7,172 tCO_{2eq}

Vintage: From 25 November 2022 to 31 July 2025

The JC expressed importance for each government to immediately make necessary arrangements to complete the first international transfer of mitigation outcomes of JCM credits for the Japanese side.

Agenda item 4. Modification of the bilateral document for the JCM

The JC considered modification of the JCM bilateral document “Low Carbon Development Partnership between the Japanese side and the Mongolian side”.

The JC decided to modify the paragraph 11, as below and adopted the “Modification of the Bilateral Document for “Low Carbon Development Partnership between the Japanese side and the Mongolian side”” dated June 30, 2026 (see attachment).

Agenda item 5. Approval of the meeting report

The JC approved the meeting report for the eighth meeting of JC.

Agenda item 6. Authorization of use of the ITMOs

The representatives from the Government of Mongolia and the Government of Japan authorized use of ITMOs by signing their respective ITMOs authorization letters for the JCM credits issued and transferred to Japan for the JCM projects MN003, MN004, MN006, and MN007.

Agenda item 7. Closing remarks by Co-Chairs

The Co-Chairs gave closing remarks and closed the meeting.
