Agenda item 3. 3. Memorandum of Cooperation on the Joint Crediting Mechanism between the Government of the Kingdom of Thailand and the Government of Japan

The Japanese side explained the summary of the proposed new Memorandum of Cooperation on the Joint Crediting Mechanism between the Government of the Kingdom of Thailand and the Government of Japan (MoC), in which the JCM is implemented consistent with Article 6 of the Paris Agreement. The proposed new MoC also accommodates domestic policy related to the Premium Thailand Voluntary Emission Reduction Program (Premium T-VER).

The JC discussed and consented to the contents of the new MoC and also consented to proceed to domestic procedures for the signing by both governments.
