## **Agenda item 3. Issuance of JCM credits**

### **Agenda item 3.1. Prey Lang Wildlife Sanctuary - Stung Treng REDD+ project (KH005)**

The JC considered the request for JCM credit issuance by the project participant of the project KH005 “Prey Lang Wildlife Sanctuary - Stung Treng REDD+ project” for the monitoring period from 12 March 2018 to 31 December 2020. The JC decided to notify each side of the amount of credits, 612,525 tCO<sub>2</sub>e, to be issued.

## **Agenda item 4. Designation as a Third-Party Entity**

### **Agenda item 4.1. Enviance Services Private Limited**

The JC considered the application for designation as a Third-Party Entity submitted by Enviance Services Private Limited based on the accreditation status of ISO 14064-2 (validation

and verification functions in sectoral scopes: 1, 3, 13, 14, 15) and decided to designate Enviance Services Private Limited as a TPE as submitted.

**Agenda item 4.1. Ampere For Renewable Energy**

The JC considered the application for designation as a Third-Party Entity submitted by Ampere For Renewable Energy based on the accreditation status of a Designated Operational Entity (DOE) under the Clean Development Mechanism (CDM) (validation and verification functions in sectoral scopes: 1, 3, 13) and decided to designate Ampere For Renewable Energy as a TPE as submitted.

**Agenda item 5. Other matters**

**Agenda item 5.1. Japan's support for the JCM partner countries**

The Japanese side explained the Article 6 Implementation Partnership programme, the need for revision of the JCM rules and guidelines consistent with Article 6 of the Paris Agreement, the JCM feasibility study and the JCM demonstration projects. The Japanese side also made a presentation on new support mechanism in the agriculture sector under the JCM, namely the development of MRV for JCM projects in agriculture.

Both sides confirmed that the agriculture sector is in the scope of the JCM, and further cooperation in the sector would be effective.
