Agenda item 3. JCM Methodology

Agenda item 3.1 Displacement of Grid and Captive Genset Electricity by a Small-scale Solar PV System

The JC considered the proposed methodology PW_PM001 "Displacement of Grid and Captive Genset Electricity by a Small-scale Solar PV System" and the public inputs received to the proposed methodology.

In response to the points raised by the public inputs, the JC concluded as following:

- i. The proposed methodology does not limit itself to small-scale solar PV projects, but in general, solar PV installed in Palau will be small-scale.
- ii. The approach for calculation in the proposed methodology may be applicable to other kind of renewable energy generation such as the wind power. However, the methodology is basically prepared for specific projects which utilize solar power. A methodology focused on wind power should be developed separately.
- iii. The current main electricity generation facility in Palau is diesel generator, and rapid uptake of substantial capacity of renewable energy generation is considered unlikely. Under the present Palauan situation, as the availability of renewable energy technologies in the local market is limited and the high initial investment is required for them, it is considered that the grid electricity would be used continuously without the proposed project assumed to be using the proposed methodology.

In addition to the public inputs received, the JC considered the followings:

- iv. The way in which the methodology ensures to displace grid electricity and captive genset electricity by electricity generated by small-scale solar PV system
- v. Amendments proposed by the methodology proponents in Eligibility Criterion 3 made after the public inputs

Based on the consideration, the JC approved the proposed methodology PW_PM001 with revisions, as contained in the <u>Annex 1</u> to this meeting report.

Agenda item 4. Rules and guidelines

Agenda item 4.1 JCM Guidelines for Designation as a Third-Party Entity

The JC considered the draft revised "Joint Crediting Mechanism Guidelines for Designation as a Third-Party Entity" and pointed out the following 4 issues needed to be considered.

- i. Definitions of "Suspension" and "Withdrawal" in section 6
- ii. Clarification of "without delay" in para 30
- iii. Limitation of the suspended TPE's activity based on its credibility
- iv. Notation of prioritized sectoral scopes for Palau

After consideration, the JC will adopt these guidelines through electronic means.

Agenda item 4.2 JCM Rules of Procedures for the Joint Committee

The JC considered the draft revised "Joint Crediting Mechanism Rules of Procedures for the Joint Committee" and adopted it, as contained in <u>Annex 2</u> to this meeting report.
