Agenda item 6.1. Promoting development of JCM projects in Thailand

The JCM secretariat of the Thai side presented the summary of activities to promote the JCM in Thailand, the expectation of the Thai side and a way forward. The expectation of the Thai side includes (1) promotion of advanced low-carbon technology transfer to Thailand, (2) selection of more Thai companies which conduct JCM Model projects in Thailand, and (3) support for development of JCM Model or Demonstration Projects based on feasibility studies.

The Japanese side explained the financing programme for the JCM model projects and ADB Trust Fund (Japan Fund for the JCM), and updated information on the JCM model projects which are currently implemented in Thailand.

The Japanese side also explained the JCM promotion scheme, JCM Demonstration Project, MRV Application Study and JCM Feasibility Study.

Agenda item 6.2. Explanation of possible schedule & contents of draft methodologies & PDDs to be submitted for JC consideration

The Japanese side explained the current status and expected schedule of the draft methodologies and PDDs to be considered by the JC. The JC confirmed the procedures for adopting decisions by electronic means.
