Guideline for submitting the result report in compliance with the Countermeasure and the Solution for the Impact on Environment, and the Monitoring Measure for the Impact on Environment, in accordance with any project concerning with industrial field, industrial estate field, or any project in the similar scope with industrial estate field and energy field.

Owing to the reference letter no.1 from ONEP had notified the consideration result on the Environmental Impact Analysis Report by the committees considering on the Environmental Impact Analysis Report in the aspect of oil refinery industry, petroleum, petrochemical, and natural gas transformation, from the meeting 52th/ 2560 as of 4 Dec 2018, which the committees had the consensus to disapprove on the detail change for the Environmental Impact Analysis Report for Project of Chlor-Alkali Plant (4th), ACTH, by recommending to add up the data information, and owing to the reference letter no.2 from ACTH which submitted the 2nd time of additional data report to ONEP for further consideration.

Office of Natural Resources and Environmental Policy and Planning (ONEP) had initially considered the report and proposed to the committees considering on the Environmental Impact Analysis Report in the aspect of oil refinery industry, petroleum, petrochemical, and natural gas transformation, from the meeting 8th/ 2561 as of 19 Feb 2018, which the committees had the consensus to approve on the detail change for the Environmental Impact Analysis Report for Project of Chlor-Alkali Plant (4th), ACTH, located at address no. 202 Moo 1, Suksawasdi Road, Moo 1, Tambol Pak Klong Bang Plakod, Amphur Prasamutjedi, Samutprakarn, by which AGC Chemicals (Thailand) Co., Ltd., has to strictly comply with and to execute follow the Countermeasure and the Solution for the Impact on Environment, and the Monitoring Measure for the Impact on Environment as stated in the report as detail on attachment no.1.

Nevertheless, if ACTH has obtained the permit from related government sectors, ONEP needs your cooperation to submit the duplicated document of the permit with its condition, toward ONEP for acknowledgement. And after start on conducting the project, ACTH must submit the result report from execution follow the Countermeasure and the Solution for the Impact on Environment, and the Monitoring Measure for the Impact on Environment as detail on attachment no.2, by which the project needed to be complied with all other relevant legal. Furthermore, the report maker of this project must gather all detailed data with chronological order of consideration by the committees for 1 volume report, including record all data into CD-ROM in the type of Portable Document Format (PDF), totally 2 units. Additionally, request to submit completed report which is already improved from the comments provided by the committees, totally 3 volume reports, including record all data into CD-ROM in the type of Portable Document Format (PDF), totally 8 units. Then, request to submit all stated items to ONEP within 1 month, this is for using as the reference evidence, and to send further to all other relevant sectors. From this matter, ONEP has already sent out the letter for notifying Consultant of Technology Co., Ltd. (COT) to further conduct in concerning process.

For your information to further proceed the concerning action.
